

# Circular Economy website - Notable changes in the backend

### How to locate the content submitted by anonymous

The new backend for locating the content submitted by anonymous users can be found at <a href="https://circulareconomy.europa.eu/platform/en/admin/content/moderated">https://circulareconomy.europa.eu/platform/en/admin/content/moderated</a>. To find this page via the admin menu, first click on the 'Content' option and then click on the 'Moderated content' option.




On that page there are appropriate filters for filtering by workflow state and/or limiting the results only to the content submitted by externals.



### How to process the workflow

To move a node from one workflow state to the next, you need to follow the steps outlined below:

- 1. Find the node
- 2. Edit the node
- 3. At the bottom of the form there are two indicators: 'Current state' and 'Change to'
- 4. Select the desired value in the 'Change to' dropdown and then click on the 'Next step' button until you reach the end of the paginated form. Then you can click on the 'Save' button.



The 'Revision log message' field is where you need to insert any comments that need to be communicated to the external users and/or any comments that should be saved with the new revision.
