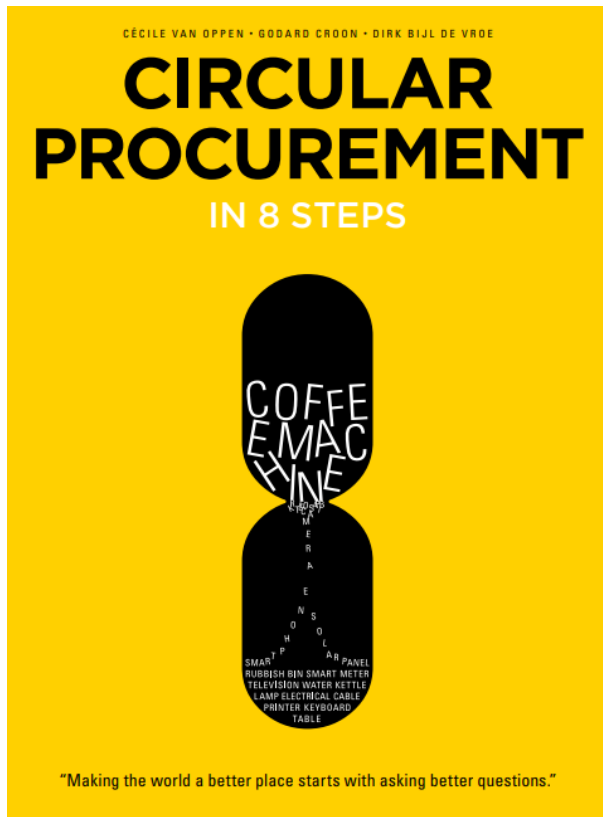

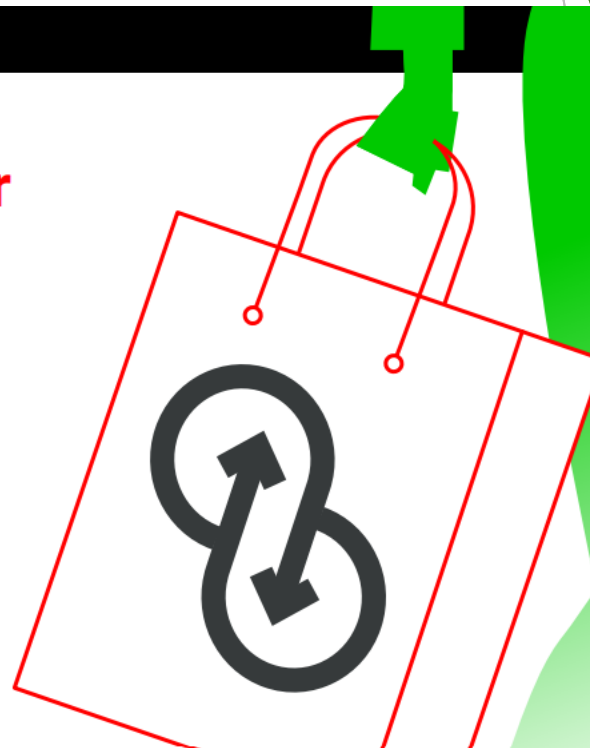

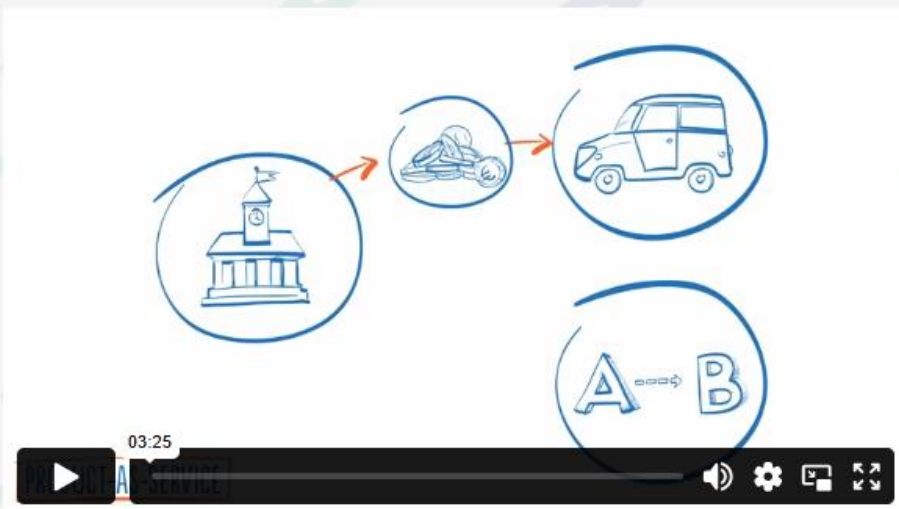

Introduction

This module is about Circular Procurement, circular economy is strongly based on the R theory: Refuse, Reform & Reduce.

Even before the circular public order, it would be necessary to rationalize the need to reduce the consumption of commodities, and that is also normalizing sobriety.

Thus, by rationalizing the needs, we can reduce the size of the order and make it is easier for the circular sector to respond/structure (for instance better evaluation of the needs for laptops makes it possible to reduce the required volume and it is then more easily absorbable for a nascent circular sector).
