### Data Protection Notice

#### 1. Introduction

The European Economic and Social Committee (EESC) is committed to respecting and protecting your personal data in accordance with [Regulation \(EU\) 2018/1725](#) (EUDPR).

Your personal data may be collected and processed for registration and follow up for the ECESP annual conference.

#### 2. Who is responsible for the processing of personal data?

The EESC is responsible (as controller) for the processing of personal data. The responsible service (data processor) is ARCTIK srl: [events@arctik.eu](mailto:events@arctik.eu).

#### 3. What is the purpose of the processing?

Your personal data will be processed in order to:

- Register you for the event
- Provide access to the venues
- Send email communications about the conference
- (if applicable) Sign-up for the ECESP newsletter

#### 4. What is the legal basis for the processing?

The legal basis for the processing of personal data is Article 5.1.a of the EUDPR, according to which "processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Union institution or body".

#### 5. What personal data are processed?

The following personal data will be processed:

- Information necessary for your registration: contact details (function/title, first name, last name, name of organisation, country, e-mail address,), nationality, passport or identity card number and its date of issue and expiry date to obtain access to the premises where the conference is held, dietary requests (if any) or specific access requirements.

#### 6. Who are the recipients or categories of recipients of your personal data?

The recipients of your data will be the European Economic and Social Committee (EESC), European Commission DG ENV, ARCTIK srl

**7. Are your personal data transferred to a third country or international organisation?**

Your personal data are not transferred to non-EU/EEA Member States or to international organisations.

**8. How can you exercise your rights?**

You have the right to access your personal data, to rectify any inaccurate or incomplete personal data, to restrict (under certain conditions) the processing of your personal data, to request the deletion of your personal data (if processed unlawfully) and, where applicable, the right to data portability. You have the right to object to the processing of your data on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time].

You can direct your queries to [CEStakeholderEU@eesc.europa.eu](mailto:CEStakeholderEU@eesc.europa.eu) Your query will be dealt without undue delay and in any event within one month of receipt of the request. That period may be extended by two further months where necessary.

You have the right of recourse to the [European Data Protection Supervisor](#) if you consider that your rights under the EUDPR have been infringed as a result of the processing of your personal data by the EESC.

**9. How long are your personal data kept for?**

Your data (excluding photos, audio and video recordings that have been published and personal data provided for accreditation purposes) will be kept for a maximum period of **12** months after the end of the event, unless you explicitly agree to your contact details being kept in order to receive invitations to future similar events organised by the ECESP.

If you wish to delete these data at any time after you have given your consent, please contact us at [CEStakeholderEU@eesc.europa.eu](mailto:CEStakeholderEU@eesc.europa.eu). Your query will be dealt without undue delay and in any event within one month of receipt of the request. That period may be extended by two further months where necessary.

Your ID card or passport number provided for accreditation purposes will be kept for 12 months. For more details on how your personal data are processed for accreditation purposes, you can consult the [accreditation privacy statement](#) available on the [EESC data protection internet page](#).

Your photos, audio and video recordings that have been published (for example on the web or in publications) will remain in that format indefinitely.

**10. Are the personal data collected used for automated decision-making, including profiling?**

The EESC will not use your personal data to make automated decisions about you. "Automated decisions" are defined as decisions made without human intervention.

**11. Will your personal data be further processed for a purpose other than that for which data have been obtained?**

Your personal data will not be further processed for a different purpose.
