ECESP content policy

Dear stakeholder,

When submitting content, please note that the ECESP editorial team takes the following aspects into consideration:

- 1. Relevance to the European circular economy
- 2. Clear, comprehensive information
- 3. Category-specific criteria
- 4. Compliance with europa.eu publishing rules.

Submissions that DO NOT meet these criteria will either be sent back for modification or rejected.

1. Relevance to the European circular economy

All content should be in line with the 2020 Circular Economy Action Plan (CEAP).

2. Clear, comprehensive information

All submissions should provide a concise, comprehensive description of the item. Information should be accurate and verifiable. The item content should be fact-based and supported by a link to original content. Other links can be added for further reading.

3. Category-specific criteria

The following categories are published on the ECESP:

- <u>Events</u> must include circularity.
- <u>Good practices</u> are practical initiatives accompanied by circular objectives and/or measurable achievements.
- <u>Strategies</u> are circular policies adopted at local, regional, national or European level.
- <u>Knowledge</u> items are research articles, studies, position papers, etc. They should be accessible free of charge.
- <u>Commitments</u> are circular and measurable objectives to be achieved by a specific deadline.
- <u>Financing</u> initiatives should focus on funding on circular economy projects.
- <u>Education</u> and training initiatives should promote the circular economy.
- <u>Networks/Platforms</u> are associations representing a specific stakeholder category be it industrial, geographical, civil society related, etc. and furthering the circular economy.

4. Compliance with europa.eu publishing rules

All content must comply with the <u>europa.eu Legal notice</u>, and should NOT:

- have a promotional or commercial purpose or
- raise ethical concerns.
