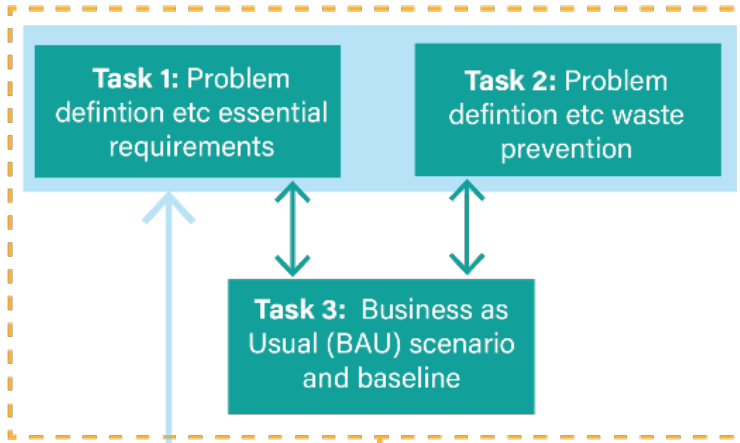

# Progress on tasks

- **Problem definitions for essential requirements, waste prevention, lightweighting and reuse have been explored and work has now begun on recycled content.**
- **A baseline Business As Usual scenario has been developed.**
- **Preliminary measures have been identified.**
- **Assessment of impacts has begun.**

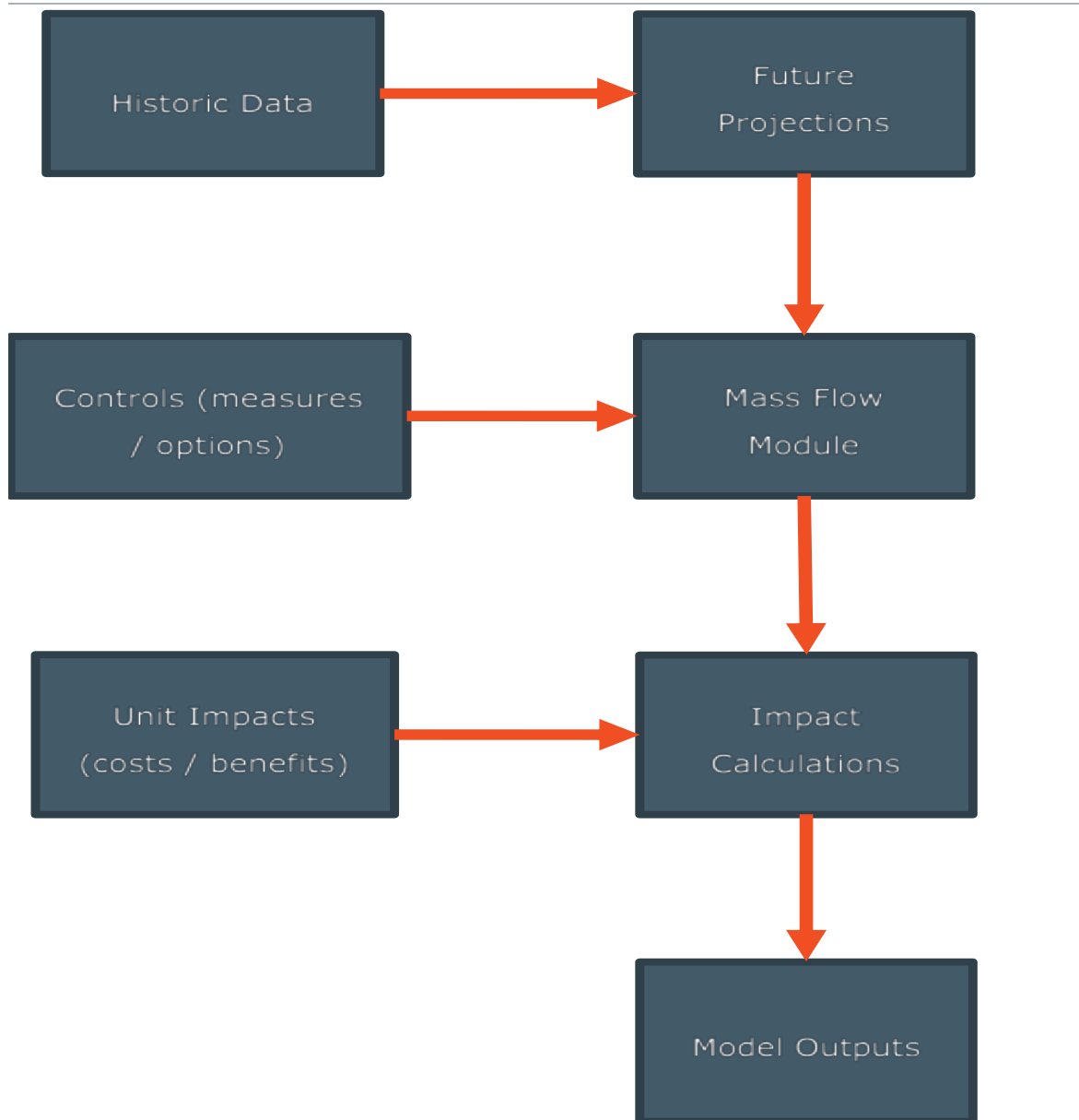
# Selection of measures

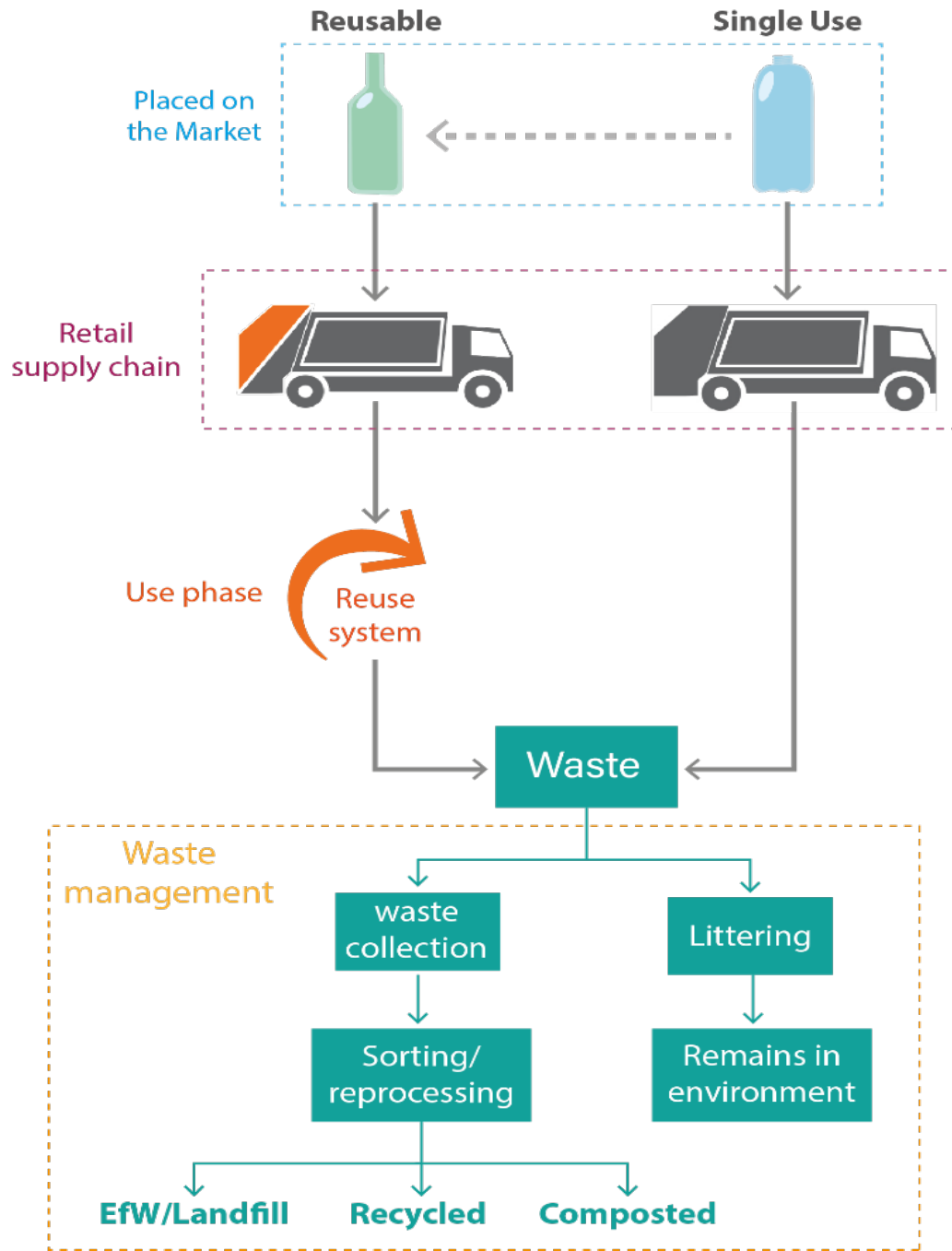
- Long list based upon literature review and initial interviews with stakeholders
- Scoping of the specific measures will be carried out e.g. which materials (glass, paper, card), product or polymer are covered by a measure.
- Initial feasibility selection process carried out on long list (e.g. applicability to EU implementation etc.) to rule out infeasible measures
- Short-list the measures
  - **Criteria: relevance to EU context, effectiveness in reducing problem drivers**
- Meeting with commission to discuss and finalise the short-list

# Themes for measures

- 1. Lightweighting**
  - 2. Reusable packaging systems**
  - 3. Recyclable packaging – change in design or system**
  - 4. Recycled Content**
  - 5. Compostable Packaging**
  - 6. E-commerce**
  - 7. Hazardousness**
  - 8. Enforcement**

# Progress on stakeholder consultation

- **Inception impact assessment feedback has been received and collated.**
- **Member State Survey closed and responses collated.**
