The EU construction industry ecosystem

- 9.6% of EU Gross Value Added (EUR 1 158 billion)
- 24.9 million jobs, 5.3 million firms
- 35.9% of waste generated, or 2.3 billion tonnes (2018)
- 36% of operational GHG emissions

- The Commission will co-create, by 2022, transition pathways towards a green, digital and resilient construction ecosystem
- High Level Construction Forum (28 September)
- Further meetings (October)

















Circular Economy Action Plan

- Waste reduction targets for specific streams and other measures on waste prevention
- Scoping the development of further EU-wide end-of-waste and byproduct criteria

Renovation Wave

- 2050 roadmap to reduce whole life carbon in buildings
- Reviewing material recovery targets and supporting the internal market for secondary raw materials
- Green public procurement criteria

- 2050 roadmap for whole life cycle emissions (Renovation Wave)
- Fit for 55: Energy Efficiency Directive proposal
 - Art.6 Exemplary role of public bodies' buildings
 - Art.7 Public procurement
