We, as MACPAC SA, focus on complying, to the fullest possible extent, with the requirements of the EU Circular Economy package.

WE INTEND TO increase our use of recycle content of the materials used up to this moment, for single-use plastics, as follows:

From 1.316,924 kilos of RPET, to 2.600.000 RPET

From 46.700 kilos of RPP, to 250.000 RPP

From 88.989 kilos of RPS, to 200.000 RPS

From total on 31/12/2017, 1.451.983 recycled material to total 31/12/2025, 3.050.000 recycled material

This will be done by 2 collection methods:

1. uptake of recycle materials from various waste bins, with the cooperation of existing specialized recycling companies
2. by devising our own collection system via sell, collect and reimburse schemes.

### **OTHER ACTIONS:**

We list below some other actions, which are planned by our company:

1. To cooperate with Municipalities and other organizations, in order to work towards the goal of zero waste.
2. Invest in education for preventing marine litter in cooperation with Municipalities
3. Participate in cleaning campaigns all over Greece and especially in beaches.
4. Promote implementation of awareness raising actions in different sectors of the Greek society.
5. Design for recyclability. Our main production consists of monomaterials and especially PET. Our products are very easily recyclable, according to our experience and do not need any further modification to achieve this goal.

HOWEVER WE ARE VERY CONCERNED TO SEE THAT THE PROPOSED NEW DIRECTIVE MOVES AWAY FROM THE SPIRIT OF THE COMMUNICATION PAPERS ISSUED ON THE 16/1/2018 AND 28/2/2018. INSTEAD OF FOCUSING ON THE CIRCULAR ECONOMY, THE NEW DIRECTIVE FOCUSES ON THE BANNING OF ITEMS OR SEVERE TAXATION AND REDUCTION MEASURES.

UNDER THOSE CIRCUMSTANCES, IT IS UNLIKELY THAT THE NECESSARY INVESTMENTS IN RECYCLING WILL TAKE PLACE AND THE ABOVE PLAN WILL BE JEOPARDISED.
